## WHO WE ARE

Our mission is to empower children and young adults, especially those who live in marginalized communities in Haiti, to experience life in its abundance, both now and in the future, through the gift of education.

## WHO WE SERVE

This generation of young people in Haiti are experiencing tremendous turmoil - natural disasters, inflation, political chaos and gang violence. These struggles are for a people who were already among the poorest in the world.

It's our privilege to serve 1200 children and 24 young adults from varied locations and backgrounds throughout Haiti, thanks to God's provision and the generosity of so many donors.

## WHY WE SERVE

Inspired by our Catholic faith, we work to equip young people to become the light in the midst of the darkness, which they face all around them.

Our staff of 21 people in Haiti and over 45 volunteers in the US strive daily to make this possible.

# CHILD SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM



In the academic year 2020-21, there were 574 students, from 50 schools across four of Haiti's 10 provinces, who participated in our child sponsorship.

For the academic year 2021-2022, added over 600 more students to the program, mostly from the Nippes province of Haiti.



Throughout the year, 14 mentors visited each child's house monthly to track their academic & overall well being.



25 Students graduated the final year of their Secondary studies which is called "Philo".

# LEARNING CENTER

The Learning Center is a Lumen Vitae administered professional school which focuses on equipping young adults who have completed their High School Graduation, with the skills necessary to work in a competitive global landscape.



A team of eight tutors, located in different parts of the United States, accompany a group of 23 English class students twice a week through zoom. Prior to teaching, each US based tutor received training on how to administer language classes virtually.

# RACE FOR THE LIGHT

Race for the Light was an initiative launched to help 500 families have access to basic food during Haiti's current socio-political and economic crisis. Over 2,500 people across the US took part in Race for the Light from October 1-30, 2020, by fundraising and keeping track of their steps while working out. Through everyone's efforts, we raised \$260,000 to feed 500 families for one year!

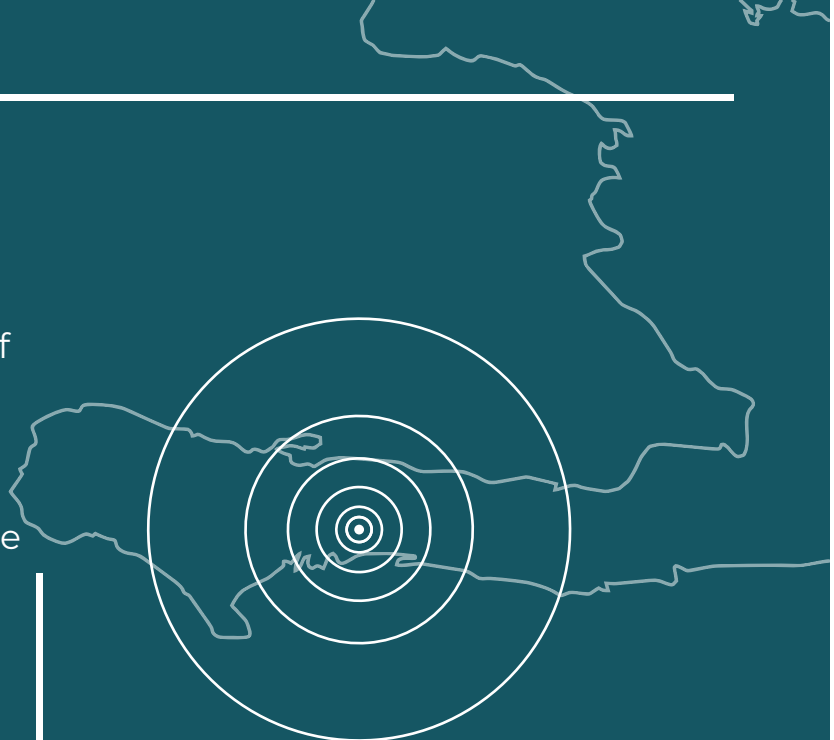

# EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

On August 14, 2021, a 7.2 magnitude earthquake struck the southern region of Haiti, leaving 650,000 people in need of assistance.

To respond to the immediate needs of the people in Nippes, where 400 families participate in our program, the Lumen Vitae team relaunched the Good Neighbor Project, collecting funds from generous donors and working with Caritas in the region.

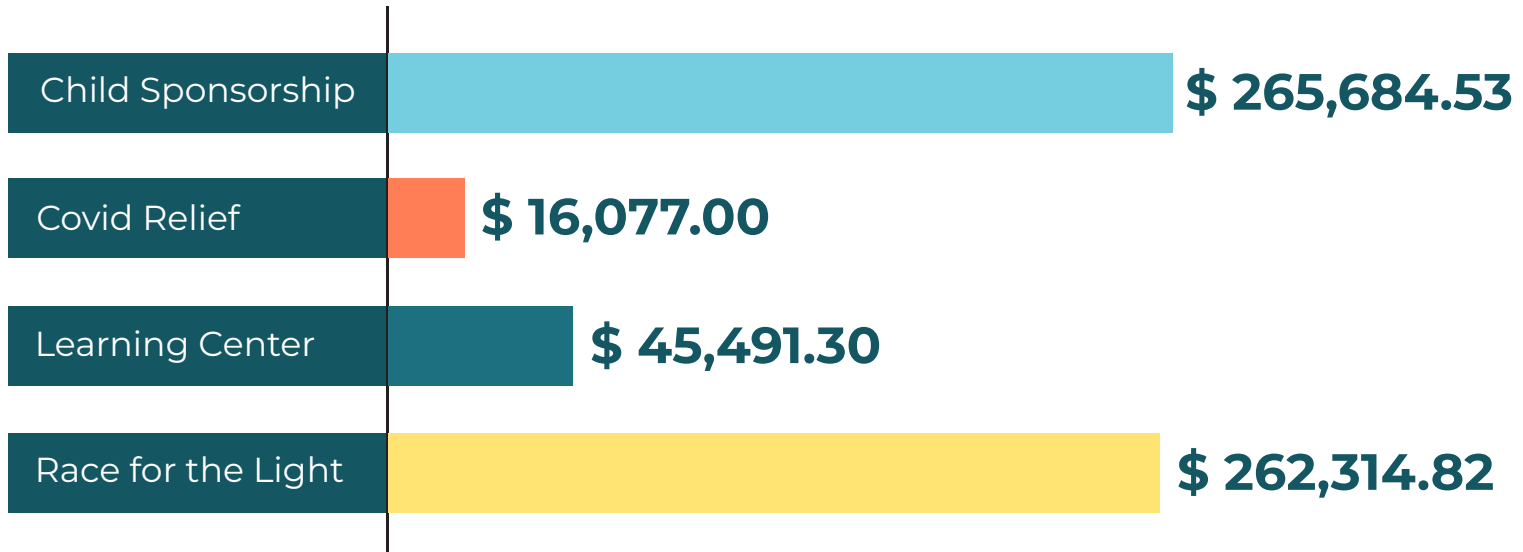

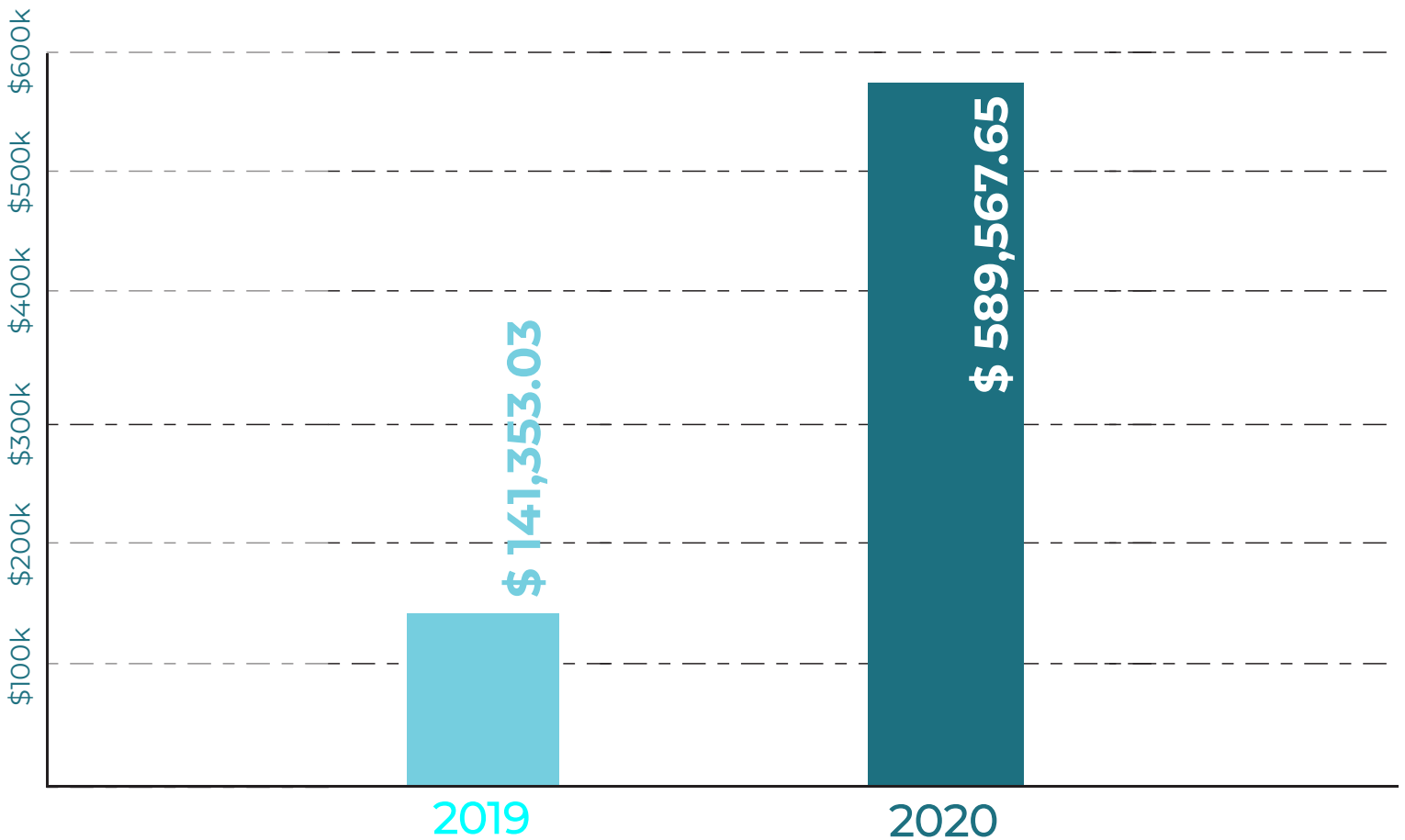

## WHAT WE RECEIVED IN DONATIONS



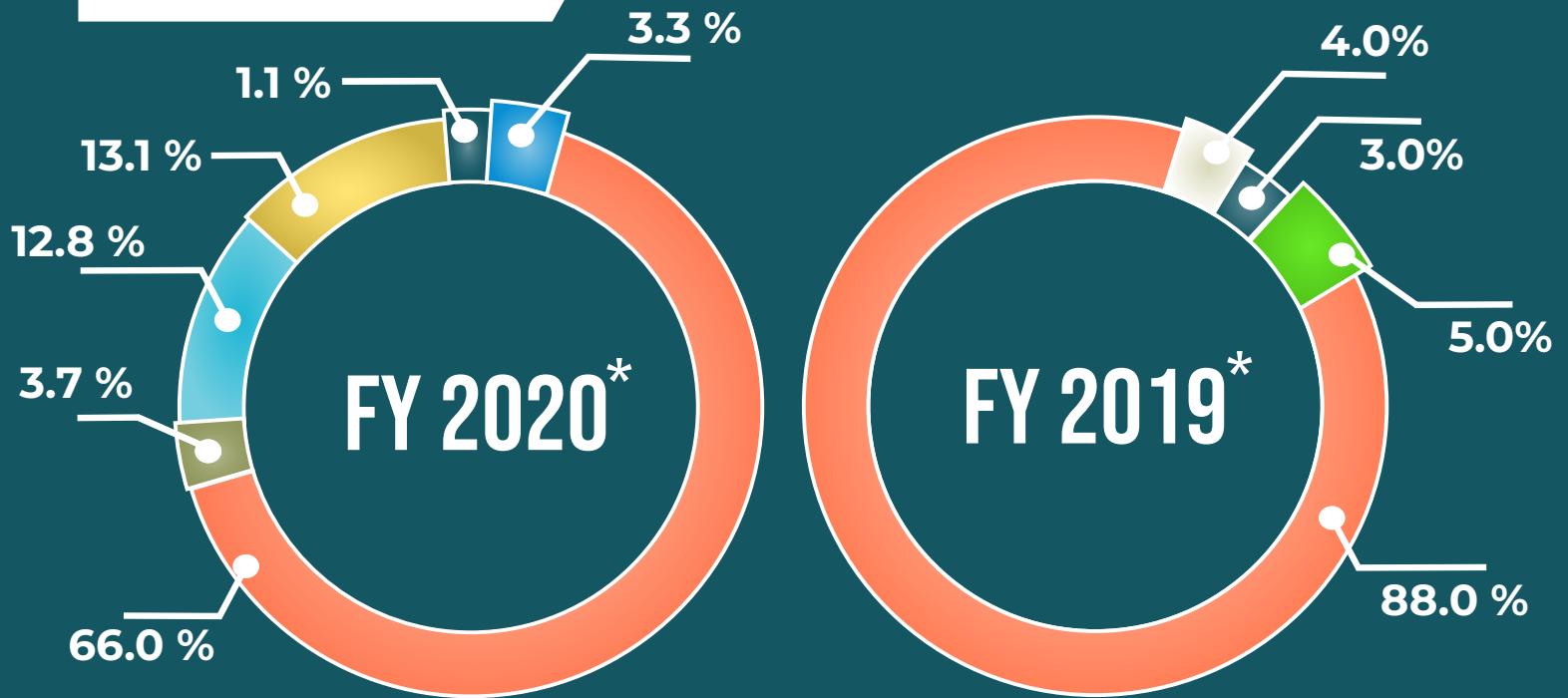
## TOTAL INCOME
