## A NEW SPRINGTIME

It is beautiful to see new flowers sprouting out after the long winter; it is also the beginning of a new season for our operations in Haiti! Our renewed Mentorship program has taken wings, giving us hope.

One of our focus areas for this year is to give a qualitative approach to our mentorship program and we are happy to inform you that as the first step, we were able to conduct a Mentors training. We saw seven new mentors coming

together from the Nippes region for a two day training on mentorship at St. Anne's Cathedral in Anse-a-Veau. Some of the topics covered included, role of a mentor, how to facilitate group sessions, and how to motivate and help our students.

The mentors will start working in full swing by April. We hope to do similar training for our mentors in the Croix-des-Bouquets region, as well.
